

## Honorary Withdrawal Card - USA

## **RULES & REGULATIONS**

- 1) Honorary Withdrawal may be granted to any member who has left the electrical industry or has been promoted to a non-bargaining unit position.
- 2) In order to obtain Honorary Withdrawal status, it shall require a majority vote at a local meeting as provided in Article XXIV of the *IBEW Constitution*.
- 3) Members must be current in the payment of their dues.
- 4) Members on Honorary Withdrawal are bound by the conditions set forth in the *IBEW* Constitution, but are not entitled to attend local union meetings or to any local union benefits.
- 5) When returning to the trade, members can only activate their membership in the local union that granted their Honorary Withdrawal.
